Lewes - 48pts -v- Warlingham Opts

If ever there was a bad day at the office this was it for Warlingham when they suffered a seven try mauling by the emerging Sussex team. With a depleted side from injuries and unavailabilities, Warlingham kicked off with a bright sun at their backs but were immediately put under pressure by a well-drilled Lewes pack. With hardly a couple of minutes on the clock Lewes were on the score sheet with a converted try before Warlingham fly half, Miles Waud, had a chance of a long penalty. The kick went just wide but from the resulting 22 metre kick Warlingham regathered and a deft chip ahead by scrum half Oli Doe fell to winger Bradley Saffery who made good ground on the right flank. Unfortunately when he was hauled down there were insufficient Warlingham numbers there to press forward.

After a second missed penalty for Warlingham, their giant lock Nick Ray was sidelined with a serious ankle injury. This upset the balance of Warlingham's scrum who were under pressure for the rest of the game. When the referee missed a blatant Lewes infringement, Warlingham were unfortunate to concede a third converted try, which was followed up with a penalty before half time.

Brothers Luke and James Delderfield tackled their hearts out and both flanker Zak King and hooker Martin Pickett drove with passion with the ball in hand. Player/coach Tom Street, closely followed by Warlingham captain James Agate, both left the field with injuries and, despite a spirited attack on the Lewes line, the home side broke clear and from a kick ahead scored their bonus-point fourth converted try. Warlingham again came back valiantly with centres Ben Wimble and Tom Campbell linking well, and when Doe put Wimble in space, a swift pass to winger Alex Skinner looked sure to put Warlingham on the score sheet.

However Lewes defended well and Skinner was bundled into touch. When Waud was led from the pitch with a neck injury, and all substitutes already deployed, Warlingham were reduced to 14 men for the last quarter. Despite battling hard the extra man, and the pacy Lewes backs, took their toll and a further three tries followed. Warlingham spurned two easy penalty shots in a commendable effort to score a try. The scores were not to be as a handling error and some hard tackling by Lewes snuffed out any chance of Warlingham getting across the line. Team Manager Tony Barrington-Doe said, "Although the injuries disrupted our game, Lewes well deserved the win. It's a long season and any long-term injuries will obviously take their toll. Fortunately we have an experienced physio in Peter Mattison and he'll need to work hard on our injured players over the next week or so"

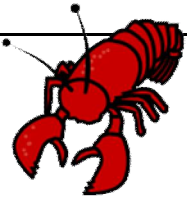

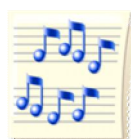
