Warlingham fall short in top table clash.

Warlingham Opts -v- East Grinstead 29pts

The "G-force" as East Grinstead like to be called, were too strong for Warlingham's gallant team in this top of the table clash at Hamsey Green. 'G's professional approach to this level of rugby soon showed when they pressurised Warlingham in the early exchanges. Showing extreme confidence the visitors spurned an early penalty kick to run at the Warlingham midfield, but to no avail as Warlingham's defence was sound. However, a well worked move in the Warlingham 22 saw their strong centre slip a tackle and score under the posts for a converted try. Warlingham flanker Zac King, and locks Nick Ray and Luke Delderfield defended well to staunch further attacks from "G" Force.

Warlingham came back strongly and had much of the territory. A long penalty attempt by scrum half Oli Doe was just short but a deft chip ahead by Warlingham fly half and captain James Agate fell to wing Alex Skinner who made good ground on the right flank. Jon Osborne took the move deeper into the 'G's 22 but, as was to be the order of the day, Warlingham lost the ball in contact and the move was thwarted. Warlingham camped on the visitor's line for a full ten minutes but were unable to turn the pressure into points. Their experienced front row of Williams, Dan Street and Abou-Zeid gave the visitors a hard time and the referee, Mr Joel Brookfield, was obliged to show a yellow card to the East Grinstead back rower for persistent infringements but, despite the extra man, Warlingham were unable to get onto the scoreboard. A second penalty kick to East Grinstead was ignored as they fancied their chances at a 'catch and drive' from a lineout. Warlingham's defence again was not breached.

At the half time whistle, and playing with the elements, Warlingham felt they were in with an excellent chance of an upset. Unfortunately they had little possession and spent the majority of the half defending and tackling ferociously. Centres Tom Cambell and Ben Wimble snuffed out several attacks and the visitors sensibly took a penalty kick to give them a 10 point lead. It was not to be Warlingham's day as a huge kick out of defence by full back Bradley Saffery rolled on the hard ground across the dead ball line and an attacking move was to no avail and play resumed back deep into the Warlingham half.

The East Grinstead pressure eventually took it's toll on the Warlingham defence and when they drove through the Warlingham pack the try line beckoned and the visitors scored their second converted try. With the home side playing catch up rugby and forcing play at every opportunity, mistakes crept into their game. 'G's took advantage and two late tries gave them the win and the bonus points. Whilst East Grinstead deserved the result, the scoreboard was flattering to them. After the game Warlingham Head Coach, Tom Street, said, "We targeted this game as the challenge of the season and we are very disappointed not to get onto the scoreboard and make a better account of ourselves. Especially disappointing was to leak the last two tries near the end of the game when we were forcing the play a bit too much."
