Warlingham 45 Pts Sevenoaks 15

This was hardly a thriller but ultimately another comfortable league victory by an improving Warlingham side over their Kent neighbours in London Division 2 South-East. It did however take a while for the scoreboard to reflect the home team's superiority.

Warlingham had a disastrous start when scrum-half Johnny Perkins twisted his ankle within 5 minutes and hobbled off. He was replaced by Ollie Doe. The home team were then penalised several times for a variety of offences and Sevenoaks stepped up and converted one such penalty to take the early lead. It took Warlingham some 20 minutes to get into the game and start pressurising the visitors, but the pack were beginning to push the Sevenoaks scrum backwards and maul considerable yards up the field. The sense of anticipation was filled after 20 minutes when omni-talented John Osborne went over after sustained pressure. Flanker Zac King then charged over the line only for the referee to judge the ball had been knocked forward. However, five minutes later flanker Tom Skinner found himself in open territory and managed to fend off several defenders and score. Agate converted.

The game had now opened up and on the half hour, the Sevenoaks right winger performed a clever kick ahead and got the luck of the bounce to bring the score back to 12-8 and a touch of tension to the home supporters.

After the interval, Warlingham lost their player coach, Tom Street to the sin bin for an unusual alleged offence that baffled everyone. The referee then binned the Sevenoaks loose-head prop for similar unclear skulduggery. That signaled Warlingham's wake up call, and they then proceeded to execute what they had been threatening to do all afternoon. They scored five further tries by Brad Saffery, Alex Skinner, Joe McEvoy, King and Ollie Doe with Mark Kozminski, on for Dan Street, converting 3 of them and adding an earlier penalty.

During the second half flurry, the Sevenoaks right winger again managed to slip defending tackles and score his second try of the afternoon to remind the home side that their defence needs to be tightened if they are going to challenge the top of this league in the latter half of the season.

Afterwards, player coach Tom Street said: "Although the score was comfortable, we have got to get our decision-making right and stop kicking away possession needlessly. As for the sin-binning, that wasn't even handbags!"

Next Saturday, Warlingham entertain Teddington in the 1st Round of the National Intermediate Cup competition. Kick-off 2.30pm at Hamsey Green.
